

R = RARE: Sparingly observed; more than 15 records; usually recorded annually

Ca = CASUAL: 5-15 records; occasionally reported

*** = ACCIDENTAL:** Only 1 or 2 sightings reported; a vagrant

SU = SUMMER (June, July)

F = FALL (August, September, October, November)


W = WINTER (December, January, February)

HOURS:

From March 1 to October 31, the area and trails are open daily 8am to 8pm Monday–Saturday and Noon–8pm Sunday. The building is closed Monday and open 8am to 5pm Tuesday–Saturday and Noon–5pm Sunday.

From November 1 to February 29, the area and trails are open daily 8am to 6pm Monday–Saturday and Noon–6pm Sunday. The building is closed Sunday and Monday and open 8am to 5pm Tuesday–Saturday.

The nature center building, trails, and area are closed on Martin Luther King, Jr. Day; Washington's Birthday; Memorial Day; Independence Day; Labor Day; Columbus Day; Thanksgiving, Christmas; New Year's Day; and other state holidays that fall on a Monday.
